

INFORMATION FOR AUTHORS

The journal is dedicated to publishing original theoretical and applicative research results and overviews on the current research status in Automation, Computer Science and Applied Informatics.

The Bulletin has the periodicity of four issues per year starting with 2006.

The access to publication of research results is open to researchers all over the world. Only original manuscripts are considered.

The following conditions have to be fulfilled by a paper in order to be accepted for publication in this journal:

- Progress of review steps, finalized by a publication proposal,
- The paper must be original,
- The paper should not have been previously or simultaneously submitted to other journals; to avoid any misunderstandings the editing format will include the receipt date and the acceptance for publication date,
- The paper must meet strictly the editing format required by the Editorial Board.

All accepted papers are published in the order set by the Editorial Board but not later than 6 months after the acceptance.

The contents of each number together with the abstracts, keywords and references (starting with 2006) are accessible on the journal webpage.

Full papers can be asked only from the authors.

The reviewing process involves the following stages:

- Receiving the paper in the required format and using the imposed technical instructions for authors; the full paper manuscript will be submitted electronically in PDF format; the editors will acknowledge the paper's arriving in good conditions, mark the date, and inform the authors about that.
- Within maximum 15 days the editors will nominate the referees and address the paper manuscript to them; peer reviewing will be accorded to each paper by three referees; in some cases the paper may be reviewed by two referees; in cases of uncertainty, the editorial board will discuss the paper and take the final decision upon publication.
- The referees will use a specific reviewing template; the paper may be recommended for:
 - Acceptance without any changes; in that case the authors will be asked to send the paper electronically in the required Microsoft Word DOC format according to the instructions for authors.
 - Acceptance with minor changes; if the authors follow the conditions imposed by referees the paper will be sent in the required Microsoft Word DOC format along with the answers to referees' comments and with a list of revisions made.

- Acceptance with major changes; if the authors follow completely the conditions imposed by referees the paper will be sent in the required Microsoft Word DOC format along with the answers to referees' comments and with a list of revisions made.
- Rejection; in that case the reasons for rejection will be transmitted to authors along with some suggestions for future improvements (if that will be considered necessary).
- In all cases, the required changes will be transmitted to authors; the changes may be accepted totally or partially by the author(s); in the latter case, the referees' requirements may be challenged by the author(s) and the paper will be submitted for a second round of reviewing.
- The date of publishing acceptance will be communicated to author(s) and printed in the final part of the published paper.
- The final camera-ready format as requested by the editors has to be transmitted by authors within 30 days after the acceptance. Any special cases have to be adjusted according to editors' demands.
